The Company

A lot of people think they are smart enough to plan the tour by themselves and of course, it's possible to do it. But the fact is there are so many unknown aspects and so many things to think about, that most of the time, the trip will end up a disappointing experience.

The budget, the destination, and the length

Your team needs to agree on the destinations, a length and of course a realistic budget. The most frequent major mistake from travel is planning to see too much! "Europe is small so we can get everywhere in no time." While that is true, the cold hard fact is that you will have a painful trip if you decide to move around too much from location to location and unpacking/packing in hotels.

Fundraising

Most of the time, teams will have to think about fundraising for the players which has been the case with some teams in the past.

Final Preparations

An important part of the final preparations is to schedule regular meetings with your Group to make sure they do not forget anything so that Unexpected things WILL not happen during your tour and it's better to be fully prepared for anything that may pop on-site. Such as allergy notices, medical insurance, travel insurance, passport photocopies, contact numbers for all people & hotels, flight tickets copies, etc. Also everyone should have a detailed itinerary so that they have a guideline of the tour.

On-site

You will have a Sports Tours Europe guide with you for your entire Tour so it should be pretty easy to go around without encountering too many problems.
